

Housing Loss Mini-Grant Program



Overview

Mālama Kaua'i is administering a flood relief mini-grant program to assist Kaua'i residents who have experienced housing destruction or loss due to the April floods. Priority recipients include those who have suffered from the loss of an owner-occupied or rented dwelling that has made their primary home uninhabitable or unsafe. Funds are intended to be used to help alleviate some of the initial financial burden taken on by applicant in developing temporary housing, securing new rental housing, or rebuilding their home. Applicant info will remain confidential and will only be used by Mālama Kaua'i and the Selection Committee for grant determination, and ultimately to better serve our community during this time of need. Only one application per structure/home. Subsequent funding and application periods may be announced should continued funding be received.

Submission & Deadline

To address the immediate and urgent needs of those impacted by loss of housing, emergency mini-grants will be awarded after June 15th, 2018. ***The deadline for applications is Friday, June 8th, 2018 - applications must be received by this date*** for consideration for funding.
