



# Spring 2019 Ag Internship Program

Monday, March 18th - Friday, March 22nd

Mālama Kauai's Ag Internship Program launched in 2015 to provide hands-on experiences, networking, and job skills to high school and college-aged students & encourage more Hawaiian youth to pursue careers in agriculture. The internship includes hands-on gardening and farming service projects, guest speakers, & more! Students will earn an hourly wage of \$10.10, a recommendation letter, & a performance evaluation upon completion.

## Program Schedule: **Monday, March 18th - Friday, March 22nd**

Internship will begin and end at the times above, with half hour break for lunch around 12:30. Interns will be expected to bring their own lunch and water bottle, as well as arrange transportation to their respective site each day. Due to the short nature of the program, **absences or sick days are not allowed**, so if you cannot make a day, or need an adjustment to your schedule, please let us know in advance. Stipends will be provided after students complete the entire program only.

**What to Bring:** We will run the program regardless of weather, so please bring:

- Sun/bug protection (hat, sunglasses, sunblock, bug spray, etc.)
- Change of clothes/layers (raincoat, pants, shorts, etc.)
- Closed toe shoes (sneakers or boots)
- Reusable water bottle
- Bagged lunch
- Gloves (if you have)
- Notebook and pen
